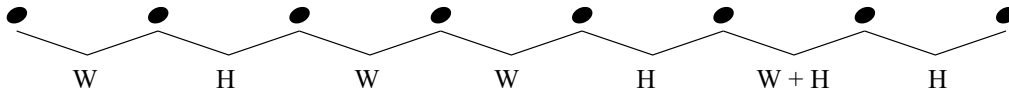


Harmonic Minor Scale

All Harmonic Minor scales are like the natural minor scale with a raised seventh degree. This raised seventh gives a leading tone to the tonic pitch and introduces a very interesting augmented 2nd interval between scale degrees 6 and 7. The formula is:



Render each of the scales below as a Harmonic Minor scale by adding the necessary sharps, naturals and/ or flats.
